Avoid city centre schools, your clients will be stuck in an office block and will have to travel far distances on a daily basis after hours.
3. All accommodation, beaches, shopping centres and night life are within walking distance from the school (5km radius).
4. Our student residence is 30m from the school and is the after-hours gathering spot of the students. The residence is self catering and provides one bathroom for every 2 bedrooms.

5. Being registered and complying with all laws, rules and regulations, Cape Studies and its clients are well insured. Lots of local schools offer cheap airport transfers and tours as part of their package. Most of these drivers do not have proper public driving licenses and the tour leaders are not registered. In case of accidents these schools are not covered.
